

CAT 41 CRUISING CATAMARAN

CAT 41 is designed to be a spacious, fast and most of all an enjoyable sailing catamaran that has the accommodations of a much larger yacht. The bridge deck and hulls have 6'4"*headroom and there is 6'2" *headroom in the forward owners state room. The forward state room has its own dresser vanity and a desk area that may be an inside steering station. Each state room has its own head with the forward state room having a shower and/or a tub. CAT 41's spacious interior allows for a number of different interior accommodation layouts to meet the owners preferences. The galley is open, spacious and 10' in length which gives the equipment and counter space to please the most gourmet of cooks. Forward of the galley is a workroom/laundry room.

The bridge deck has a comfortable lounge that may convert to a berth. Next to the lounge there is a large navigation center and office. The large cockpit seats all and may be protected at anchor with a boom tent and a dodger at sea, to add to the enjoyment of all. Forward of the mast, the full width of the cabin there is a bench seat for lounging. Webbing between the bows can be walked on for sail handling, anchoring or for comfortable lounging and sunbathing.

CAT 41 has all the features a catamaran should have so as to provide its owner with exceptional sailing and cruising comforts, plus building is easy and fast with Tri-Star's comprehensive plans. CAT 41 is truly a catamaran yacht that will be enjoyed by all.
